Question No. 5 but instead proceed to Question No. 6]

Question No. 5: Using 100% as the total combined fault of plaintiff and defendant
which was a cause of plaintiff's damage, what percentage of such combined fault do you
assign to the plaintiff and what percentage of such combined fault do you assign to the
defendant?

ANSWER:	Plaintiff	<u>60</u> %
	Defendant	<u>40</u> %
	Total	100%

Question No. 6: State the amount of damages, if any, sustained by the Plaintiff by Defendant's fault as to each of the following items of damage.
