FORM OF VERDICT

We find the following verdict on the questions submitted to us:

Question No. 1: Was Mr. Kramer at fault for failure to mitigate his damages for vehicle storage?

Answer "yes" or "no."

Question No. 2: Was Mr. Kramer's fault from question 1 a cause of any damage to Mr. Kramer?

ANSWER: yes

If your answer is "no," do not answer Question No. 3.

Question No. 3: Using 100% as the total combined fault of Mr. Kramer and Ms. Gruis which was a cause of Mr. Kramer's damage after Mr. Kramer's fault occurred, what percentage of such combined fault do you assign to Mr. Kramer and what percentage of such combined fault do you assign to Ms. Gruis?

ANSWER: Mr. Kramer 99 %
Ms. Gruis 1 %
TOTAL 100%

If you find Mr. Kramer to be more than 50% at fault, do not answer Item 10 on Question No. 4 but answer items 1-9 on Question No. 4.

Question No. 4: State the amount of damages sustained by Mr. Kramer because of Ms. Gruis' fault as to each of the following items of damage. Do not take into consideration any reduction of damages due to Mr. Kramer's fault. If the Mr. Kramer has failed to prove any item of damage, or has failed to prove that any item of damage was caused by Ms. Gruis' fault, enter 0 for that item.

1. Past medical expenses	\$ <u>20,396.24</u>
2. Future medical expenses	\$ <u>412.93</u>
3. Past pain and suffering	\$ <u>75,000.00</u>
4. Future pain and suffering	\$ <u>87,500.00</u>
5. Past loss of full mind and body	\$ <u>37,500.00</u>
6. Future loss of full mind and body	\$ <u>43,750.00</u>
7. Loss of time – earnings	\$ <u>10,000.00</u>
