SPECIAL VERDICT FORM

We, the jury, find the following verdict on the questions submitted to us:

Released Party — Ong Lor

QUESTION NO. 1. Was Ong Lor, who has been released, at fault?

Answer "yes" or "no": yes

[If your answer is "no," do not answer Question No. 2 and proceed to Question No. 3. If your answer is "yes," answer Question No. 2.]

QUESTION NO. 2. Was the fault of Ong Lor a cause of any item of damage to the Plaintiff Daniel Khang?

Answer "yes" or "no": yes

[If your answer to either Question No. 1 or No. 2 is "no," you shall not assign any fault to Ong Lor. Proceed to Question No. 3.]

Released Party — Chakhon Khang

QUESTION NO. 5. Was Chakhon Khang, who has been released, at fault?

Answer "yes" or "no": yes

[If your answer is "no," do not answer Question No. 6 and proceed to Question No. 7. If your answer is "yes," answer Question No. 6.]

QUESTION NO. 6. Was the fault of Chakhon Khang a cause of any item of damage to the Plaintiff Daniel Khang?

Answer "yes" or "no": yes

[If your answer to either Question No. 5 or No. 6 is "no," you shall not assign any fault to Chakhon Khang. Proceed to Question No. 7.]

Plaintiff — Daniel Khang

QUESTION NO. 7. Was Plaintiff Daniel Khang at fault?

Answer "yes" or "no": no

[If your answer is "no," do not answer Question No. 8 and proceed to Question No. 9. If your answer is "yes," answer Question No. 8.]

QUESTION NO. 8. Was the fault of Plaintiff Daniel Khang a cause of any item of damage to himself?

Answer "yes" or "no": _____

[If your answer to either Question No. 7 or No. 8 is "no," you shall not assign any fault to Plaintiff. Proceed to Question No. 9.]

Apportionment of Fault

QUESTION NO. 9. Using 100% as the total combined fault of all parties which was a cause of Plaintiff Daniel Khang's damage, what percentage of such combined fault do you assign to each of the following? Enter "0" for any party you previously found was not at fault or did not cause damage.

Note: The Court has established that Defendant Chong Xiong is strictly liable. You must still assign him a percentage of the total fault for apportionment purposes.

Ong Lor 15 %

Chakhon Khang 40 %

Defendant Chong Xiong 45 %

Plaintiff Daniel Khang 0 %

[If you find Plaintiff Daniel Khang's fault to be more than 50% of the total, do not answer Question No. 10. Sign and date the verdict form and notify the Court Attendant. If Plaintiff's fault is 50% or less, answer Question No. 10.]

QUESTION NO. 10. State the total amount of damages sustained by Plaintiff Daniel Khang caused by the dog attack. Do not reduce the amounts for any party's fault — the Court will make that reduction. If Plaintiff has failed to prove any item of damage, enter \$0.00 for that item.
