Question No. 4: Was Plaintiff Susan Heun's fault a legal cause of any damage to the Plaintiffs?

Answer "yes" or "no."

ANSWER: Yes

[If your answer is "yes", proceed to Question No. 5. If your answer is "no," enter 0 for the Plaintiff, Susan Heun, in Question No. 5 and proceed to Question 6.]

Question No. 5: Using 100% as the total combined fault of Plaintiff Susan Heun and Defendant Bonnie Henderson which was a legal cause of Plaintiffs' damages, what percentage of such combined fault do you assign to the Plaintiff Susan Heun and what percentage of such combined fault do you assign to the Defendant Bonnie Henderson?

ANSWER: Susan Heun	<u>50</u> %
Bonnie Henderson	<u>50</u> %

Question No. 6. State the amount of damages sustained by the Plaintiff Susan Heun proximately caused by Defendant's fault as to each of the following item of damages. Do not take into consideration any reduction of damages due to Plaintiff Susan Heun's fault. If the Plaintiff Susan Heun has failed to prove any item of damage, or has failed to prove that any item of damage was proximately caused by Defendant's fault, enter 0 for that item.

1. Past pain, suffering, and mental anguish	\$ <u>-0-</u>
2. Past loss of function of the body	\$ <u>-0-</u>
3. Past medical expense	\$ <u>143.17</u>
4. Loss of Consortium	\$ <u>0</u>

1. Past loss of time from business and loss of earnings	\$ <u>599.63</u>
2. Past medical expense	\$ <u>2,525.64</u>
3. Future medical expense	\$ <u>-0-</u>
4. Past loss of function of the body	\$ <u>-0-</u>
5. Past pain, suffering, and mental anguish	\$ <u>-0-</u>
6. Future pain, suffering, and mental anguish	\$ <u>-0-</u>
